Keynote Address

Bryan Simmons, President of Coast Flight Thursday, September 14



The U.S. airline industry is facing a critical shortage of pilots-with more than 617,000-trained pilots needed by 2035, according to studies by Boeing. Coast Flight is a professional flight training facility that assists with schooling U.S. military helicopter pilots who are transitioning to in-demand careers as civilian airline pilots for that nation's top airlines.

Coast Air also advances civilian aviation pilots into airline careers through its strong relationships with several airlines. The growth of this program has allowed Coast Flight to expand outside of California and into San Marcos, Texas. Currently Coast Flight has a well over 80 aircraft within their fleet.

Simmons served as Presidential Command Pilot for two U.S. presidents on Marine One.
